



## 52<sup>nd</sup> Anniversary Poster Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to all enrolled students within the Bainbridge Island School District or any private school on Bainbridge Island.
2. Theme for the poster is: “The land of the free and the home of the \_\_\_\_\_”
3. Format for the poster is to be hand drawn. Pen, pencil, paint or crayon may be used. No electronic or digital productions will be considered.
4. The poster is to be completed on paper or card stock no larger than 11” x 17”, with a 6” x 11” space at the bottom (see diagram to the right)
5. Posters must be turned into the Chamber office (395 Winslow Way E.) by February 15, 2019. No late entries will be accepted.
6. Judging will take place during the month of February, with the winner announced by March 15, 2019.
7. The winning poster will become the property of the Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce and will be used in the promotion of the 2019 Grand Old Fourth of July event. The winner’s name, and sponsor, Puget Sound Energy, will be on the poster when produced.
8. The scholarship (\$1,000.00) will be awarded by Puget Sound Energy at a press conference (date and time to be determined).
