



53rd Anniversary Poster Contest Rules

1. Contest is open to all students enrolled within the Bainbridge Island School District or any private school on Bainbridge Island or home-schooled on Bainbridge. There is no cost to submit an entry.
2. Theme for the poster is: "My favorite thing about the 4th of July on Bainbridge Island" Please DO NOT include these words in your drawing.
3. Format for the poster is to be hand drawn. Pen, pencil, paint or crayon may be used. No electronic or digital productions will be considered.
4. The poster is to be completed on paper or card stock no larger than 11" x 17", with a 6" x 11" space at the bottom (see diagram to the right)
5. Posters must be turned into the Chamber office (395 Winslow Way E.) by April 1, 2020. No late entries will be accepted.
6. Judging will take place during the week of April 6.
7. The winning poster will become the property of the Bainbridge Island Chamber of Commerce and will be used in the promotion of the 2020 Grand Old Fourth of July event. The winner's name, and sponsor, Puget Sound Energy, will be on the poster when produced.
8. The scholarship (\$1,000.00) will be awarded by Puget Sound Energy.
