This award is made possible by the generosity of John Ellis and late Frank Buxton, members of the EDGE Improv group and veteran Grand Old 4th parade announcers. The announcers will decide the winner. If the winning entry is a non-profit organization, it may keep the money. If the winning entry is not a non-profit organization, it will donate the money to the Bainbridge Island/Kitsap County non-profit organization of its choice, designated on the parade application. Remember the VW bus toaster? The power drill team? The giant pie slices? Get creative and join the fun!

Parade Entry Guidelines

Please decorate all people, animals, bikes, cars, trucks, flatbeds etc. in your entry

- 1. PARADE STANDARDS:** The 4th of July Parade Committee reserves the right to bar from the parade, either at assembly, or any time during the parade, any entrant not conforming to these rules, or judged to be not in good taste, or not meeting safety standards, or refusing to follow the instructions of the Police or Parade Officials.
- 2. DEADLINE & ENTRY FEE:** **Due by Fri. June 19** Commercial & political \$40, Other \$30. No cost for military entrants. After June 21, entries must be delivered in person to the Chamber of Commerce office and will be charged an extra \$5.00. Entries received after June 22 will be placed at the end of the parade and may not be read by the announcer.
- 3. MAXIMUM NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS:** Maximum number of participants for any one entry shall be limited to 60 total members walking, escorting or riding.
- 4. PERFORMING UNITS:** Timing of a performance is critical for parade safety. Units must not cause gaps to occur in the parade. You must keep pace with the parade. You will be allowed one 60 second performance in front of each parade announcer stand along the parade route (total of 3).
- 5. ANIMAL UNITS:** Each animal unit must furnish a clean-up crew, equipped with appropriate tools. They must follow directly behind the horse and/or animal unit and clean up as quickly as possible. Please bring water for your animals.

- 6. VEHICLES AND FLOATS:** All vehicles must be in good mechanical condition and mufflers in good repair. ALL FLOATS MUST CONFORM TO THE FOLLOWING RULES:
- A. Entry over 30 feet must have one (1) person on each side to walk with the entry to keep pedestrians from entering the traffic pattern.
 - B. Entry over 50 feet must have two (2) people on each side to walk with the entry to keep pedestrians from entering the traffic pattern.
 - C. For reasons of safety and liability, **THROWING OF CANDY, MERCHANDISE, WATER BALLOONS, OR USE OF SQUIRT GUNS OR SOAKERS, ETC. IS NOT ALLOWED FROM FLOATS OR VEHICLES DURING THE PARADE.** Any entry doing so will be removed from the parade and will not be allowed to participate. Walking entrants escorting units may distribute items, hand-to-hand only, **NO THROWING.**
 - D. All vehicles must provide a description of the vehicle (including license plate number) and insurance company and policy number.
- 7. TIME AND STAGING AREA:** Parade placement will be available only on July 4 upon check in. One member of your group must check in at the Registrar's Desk at the Bainbridge Island Library between 11:15 a.m. and 12:15 p.m. to sign in and pick up your Parade Permit and Entry Number. A Parade Official will direct you to your place in the parade staging area. Staging Areas are labeled "A", "B", "C" and "D". The parade begins at 1 pm. Be in position with all participants by 12:30 pm.
- 8 PARADE PERMIT:** YOUR PARADE PERMIT SHOULD BE VISIBLY DISPLAYED ON THE LEFT FRONT OF YOUR ENTRY. The Parade Permit allows Parade Officials and the Review Stand to easily identify your entry.
- 9. DISBANDING AREA:** For safety reasons, all units and riders on all floats must remain in position or on floats until the end of the parade route. No units may stop until after the following designated areas:
- A. CHILDREN'S UNITS walking or riding, make sure someone is available to help children quickly and safely off the floats.
 - B. POLICE, LARGE VEHICLES and FIRE TRUCKS - go straight on Winslow Way to Highway 305.
 - C. CARS, floats, classic cars and other entries - turn left on Erickson Avenue.
- 10. ALL ENTRIES:** All entrants must sign the indemnity agreement on the Parade Entry Application.
